

Ear Notching


Both commercial swine and show pigs are individually identified using a universal system known as ear notching. Ear-notching helps identify a pig's litter and which pig in the litter it is, giving each pig a unique identity number. Notches are placed in one of five locations in the pig's ear. Learning to read ear notches is a valuable tool, not only for identifying animals but because reading ear notches is a very common showmanship question.

The notches in the	ear represent individual pig number





Question 1.


The notches in the **RIGHT** ear represent litter number.
